Q8: In the churchyard what is the name of the flower that tracks the sun?

A: Morning Glory on the sundial

Q9: According to the History of Kerry Information Board, what do Rhiw-Dan-Tin Farm, Cwm Quarry and Cefn Craig Wood have in common?

A: They are all end points of branches of the Kerry Railway

Q10: What colour is Boot Cottage?

A: Pink

Q11: What kind of choice does the Village Shop and Post Office offer?

A: Family Choice (sign on the west side of the shop)

Q12: What is sitting on a mushroom between Bay Cottage and Penarran View?

A: Pixie, Imp, Leprechaun, Gnome (not quite sure exactly) – on the door knocker

Q13: How many diamond shaped rhomboids can you see on the front side of Dolforgan Lodge?

A: 45 (at the top of each of the three mock arch windows)

Q14: What is the maximum age for children to use the play facilities?

A: 7 (i.e. Under 8)

Q15: There is one tree lining the path that is different from the rest. One obvious thing is that it has a metal barrier around it. What's the other difference?

A: Its the only tree that is NOT an oak tree (all the rest are)

Q16: Where can you find fixing posts identical to those used for Dolforgan Bridge?

A: Pontcysyllte Aqueduct

Q17: What brothers sit between the two dugouts for Home & Away?

A: Lovatt Brothers (advertisement board)

Q18: The time might be stuck at 5.47. But what is the year stuck at?

A: 1900 (inscription below the clock on Melin Coed near the Kerry Sawmill)

Q19: What creatures flank the Dragon?

A: Eagles (or similar birds of prey) at 10 Dolforgan View

Q20: What colour is the gnomes jacket?

A: Yellow – the Gnome stands proudly at 56 Dolforgan View

A: 30480 KG Max Gr. (At Herbert Arms Farm)
