TPO on Sarn Oaks.

Letter sent to Gwilym Davies at PCC on the 21st. September 2018.

“As a result of planning application P/2016/0722 for 60 dwellings on land owned by PCC in Sarn, Kerry Community Council (KCC) put in an application for TPO on 3 Oak trees on that land.

We were informed during late 2017 that it was still being considered but if building went ahead a TPO would automatically be enforced. Since then we have heard nothing until a few days ago when a resident rang to inform us that works have been carried out on one of the trees.

Can you kindly investigate as to what work has been done and by whom? KCC was advised on application for a TPO that it would only take 6 weeks.

KCC are due to meet on the 26th September and I would be grateful to be able to update them on this issue at that meeting.”

As of the meeting date, no response has been made. Council suggest the Clerk should make a second request for information if no response is received within the next 14 days.
