KCC Planning Consultations - P/2017/0392 11/04/2017 Cwm Dirgel, Sarn SY16 4LS Full: Erection of a replacement dwelling, installation of sewage treatment plant, erection of a detached garage and all associated works KCC's response as submitted 15th June. "Council await the outcome of the Archaeological report, when they will respond to the resubmitted application." Archaeological report now to hand, council to reconsider. "Having knowledge of the additional significant information; Council concur

with the views expressed by Mark Walters of the Clwyd-Powys Archaeological Trust and support the suggested submission of an alternative proposal to attain a more sympathetic restoration".
P/2017/0799 Grid ref: 319967.49/290864.77 7 Min Y Sarn, Sarn, Erection of a front porch on existing dwelling KCC Response. "Council wishes to support this application".

A.O.B. Councillors expressed concern over the future of the recently closed public house in the village. Growing concern is shown on the continuing decline in maintenance work on minor roads in Sarn. It is felt, in parts, they are beyond repair due to neglect; the lack of drain clearing on these roads adding to the damage. The clerk is requested to write to the Head of Highways highlighting Council's views.
