KCC “Pop in” Sessions.

Council confirmed the next session is to be held from 6-30pm. - 7.15pm. at the Herbert Arms, Kerry on Wednesday 26th September 2018. It was decided to rename the project “Meet Your Community Councillor” and to hold sessions at Dolfor and Sarn next year. Although the original session was spearheaded by four Councillors it is generally accepted that gathering for a drink to talk to residents before the meeting is an exercise that would benefit from “the more the merrier” and a number of Councillors expressed intent to attend.

Concerns on planning procedures for Agricultural/ Intensive Farming Systems

Letter sent to Gwilym Davies, Head of Planning, PCC. on the 6th July 2018.

Response received 24th July as follows: *“I understand the Community Councils concerns regarding buildings consented for general agricultural use being used for intensive pig farming. We are currently looking at potential options to address this issue but must stress that this is not a simple as it appears especially when developers use the agricultural notification process, where Welsh Government planning policy states that Planning Departments may concern themselves only with siting, design and appearance. Discussions are ongoing with our legal department regarding the legality of some of the measure that we are proposing and it is hoped that we will be able to confirm a stance within the next few weeks.”*
