

Special meeting of the Parish Council
held at the Reading Room on Friday
March 9th 1920 at 6-45 pm

Present: Councillors P. A. Corfield, G. Gault,
H. H. Jones, D. S. Jones, J. Jones, E. Morgan
& D. Morgan

In the unavoidable absence of the Chairman
a Vice-Chairman Councillor P. A. Corfield proposed
& Councillor D. S. Jones seconded that Councillor P.
Morgan be voted to the Chair. Carried unanimously.

The Clerk read a letter received from West Haverhill
relating on behalf of the Trustees of the Bygoneshall
estate offering the Reading Room to the Parish
Council for the use of the inhabitants
of Hury.

A draft of the Deed of Trust was also received.
The Clerk reported that he had consulted the
Chairman on the matter who considered that
the offer was a very generous one, but he was
not quite satisfied with the clause referring
to the constitution of the Committee of Management
which stated that the two Churchwardens should be
ex officio members of the Committee, but no mention
was made of a non-conformist representative.

The matter having been fully discussed by the
Council, it was proposed by Councillor Corfield
seconded by Councillor Gault that the offer
be accepted. Carried unanimously.
The Clerk was instructed to write and accept
the offer.

A Circular from the County Agricultural Education
Committee in reference to Agricultural experiments
was also considered, & after discussion Councillor
D. S. Jones proposed & Councillor Corfield seconded
that no action be taken. Carried unanimously.

An account from W. C. H. Hidding for 8/- expenses
of Agricultural lectures at Sarum was passed &
a cheque for the amount signed.
