A Special Meeting of the Parish Council was held at the Reading Room on Tuesday Nov 25th at 9 o'clock.

The minutes of the last meeting held Nov 11th were read and confirmed.

A letter was received from Mr. Wilkes, thanking the Council for their kind expressions of sympathy with Mr. Wilkes in his illness, & their regret at his resignation.

Appointment of Clerk

Applications for the post of Clerk & Assistant Currier were received from Mr. Evan Goble, Linsburyard, & L. D. Morgan Rose Hill.

It being decided to make the election by ballot, each applicant received an equal number of votes, the Chairman giving his casting vote in favour of L. D. Morgan, who was thereupon appointed at a salary of £35 yearly.

Lectures

In reference to correspondence which had passed between the Chairman & Mr. John, it was decided to hold a public singing class on Dec 10, 11 & 12th to be followed by a lecture on the same subject to be given on the 17th Dec.

It was also decided to have an Agricultural Lecture on Jan 2 1920.

Cemetery.

The Chairman proposed & Mr. Corfield seconded that a parish meeting be called for the purpose of adopting the Burial Act 1852 to 1885 so that the requirements of the Ministry of Health might be complied with. It was decided to hold the meeting on 16th December.
