Breaking News. Following an uncontested election, Cllr. Dyer and Cllr. David Jones were returned as Sarn councillors. KCC seeks to co-opt one more Sarn representative. Jo Cox Foundation Get Together Day. (Litter Picking) Cllr. V. Wildish addressed council on possible events for the day. St Michael's School has been approached with the view to involving the children. It is intended to make the day as cost free as possible by encouraging families to bringing food for a joint picnic with entertainment similar to May Day celebrations. Local businesses could be approached to see if they wish to show an interest. Saturday 17th June to be the big picnic in the hope that village litter picking can be encouraged for Sunday 18th June. It was highlighted that these events are for Sarn and Dolfor to enjoy and should be advertised in all three villages. KCC Planning Consultations P/2017/0021 White Hopton Farm, Wern Lane, Sarn SY16 4EN Proposed extension. KCC Council has no objection to this application. PCC Planning Notices P/2016/1200 24/11/2016 Focus School - Newtown Campus Sarn SY16 4EJ Continued siting of a temporary portakabin (2 years) for use as a class room. KCC suggests that, although in breach of the 2014 planning condition the portakabin should remain in use until July 2017 bringing it in line with the end of the academic year. After that date KCC wishes the removal of the portakabin re-affirming their original concerns made in 2014. However, PCC have given conditional consent with removal after a further 2 years. (See website kerrycommunitycouncil.gov.uk for further details) This prompted considerable discussion. Some KCC Councillors expressed grave concern about the decision made by the Planning Committee. It was duly proposed and seconded that 'In the light of the PCC Decision on P/2016/1220. KCC should make no response to the current Planning Applications on the agenda'. The motion was put to the vote and defeated. Council was then asked to accept the resignation of Cllr. O Stanier (Sarn) and it was accepted with regret. The Clerk was asked to find out whether there is a Complaints Procedure which could be used if KCC wished to pursue further investigations of PCC's Planning Department actions on this and other Planning Applications. Hester confirmed he will undertake the internal audit for 2016/7. A.O.B. Sarn Oaks - Louise Evans (CSP - Development Control) intends placing a TPO on the trees if the residential planning application is granted.
